NOVEMBER DEMONSTRATION

Ed Cole was our November demonstrator showing all the steps in making a ring. He explained all the equipment he will be using and how the ring mandrel works with the three sizes of bushings. (Small, Medium, Large) The mandrel can also be used for making a bottle stopper. Ed went through how to choose the correct ring size and all the different type of rings cores that can be purchased. He showed the rings he made from acrylics, inlaid and solid wood pieces. You can watch Ed's demo and other demos by going to YouTube and searching Bay Lake Woodturners. Once on our site just click on the video you would like to watch. We have two ring rental kits in our store with the mandrel and bushings.

RING RENTAL KITS

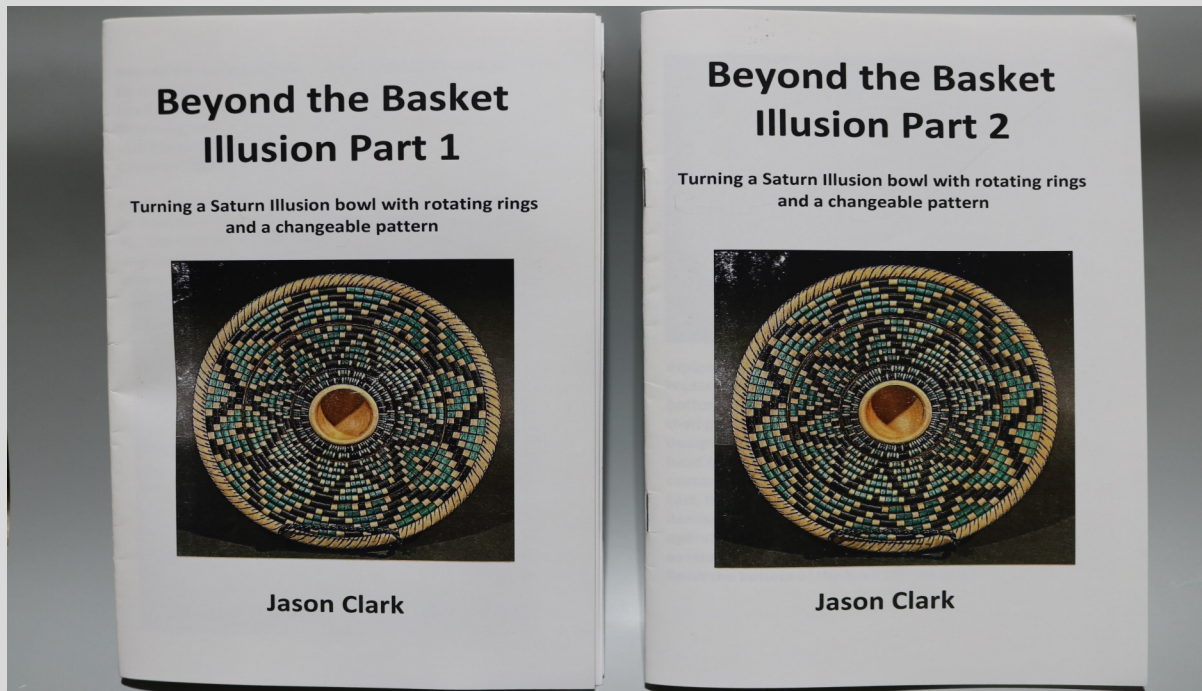
We now have two ring kits that can be rented from our store and the cost is \$3.00 per kit. You can check the ring kit out at a meeting and then bring it back to the next meeting. The kits have two different size mandrels. One kit has a 1 x 8 TPI for smaller lathes and the other is 1 1/4 x 8 TPI for larger lathes. The kits include a mandrel with nut and bushings for small, medium and large rings. You will need to furnish a ring core, either acrylic blank or wood and a finish. Please place all the parts back in the zip bags so we don't lose any pieces.
